#### **APOSTLE ERIC NYAMEKYE ELECTED AS PRESIDENT OF GHANA PENTECOSTAL AND CHARISMATIC COUNCIL (GPCC)**

The Ghana Pentecostal and Charismatic Council (GPCC) at her 2023 Conference of Heads of Churches and Organizations (CHCO), and Extra-Ordinary National Delegates Conference held at the Pentecost Convention Center (PCC) from Tuesday 31<sup>st</sup> January 2023 to Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2023, elected Apostle Eric Kwabena Nyamekye, the current Chairman of the Church of Pentecost as the new President of the Council. He takes over from Rev. Prof. Paul Frimpong Manso whose tenure as President ended on 7th December, 2022.

The 3-Day Conference which was held under the theme ***“United for God’s Glory”*** (John 17:21) brought together, members of the GPCC National Executive Council (NEC), Heads of GPCC Member-Churches and their Secretaries, GPCC Regional Executive Council Chairmen and Secretaries as well as leaders of Para-church Organizations who are members of the GPCC.

The Extra-Ordinary National Delegates Conference which was held on the last day of the programme, ratified the 7th December 2022 decision of the National Executive Council which had unanimously nominated Apostle Eric Nyamekye to succeed the outgoing President, Rev. Prof. Frimpong Manso. The nomination by the NEC was ratified by 190 Delegates who were present at the Conference. The President of The Apostolic Church-Ghana, Apostle Dr. Aaron Ami-Narh was also elected as the 2nd Vice President of the Council. Bishop Gordon Kisseih, the Presiding Bishop of the Life International Church, is currently the 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President of the Council. The President, Apostle Eric Nyamekye comes into this high office with a great wealth of ministry experience including being a current Advisory Board Member of the World Pentecostal Fellowship. It is expected that two (2) additional members will be elected at the June 2023 National Delegates Conference to make up the 15 members. The election of the current President is expected to usher the GPCC to new heights as an ecumenical body.

Speakers at the Conference included Apostle Dr. Aaron Ami-Narh (The Apostolic Church-Ghana), Apostle General, Most Rev. Sam Korankye-Ankrah (Royalhouse Chapel International), and Bishop Dr. Gordon Kisseih (Life International Church). Dr. George Manful, an environmental and natural resources expert from the Frimpong-Manso Institute, also made a presentation on the devastating effects of galamsey and environmental pollution in Ghana.

The Conference among other things, deliberated on some pertinent issues prevailing in, and of concern to the nation Ghana and Ghanaians. These issues included the Domestic Debt Exchange Programme (DDEP), worsening macro-economic indicators and their effect on the livelihood of the citizens, and the Auditor General's 2021 Report which brought to the fore considerable degrees of financial misappropriations, in public sector institutions.

At the end of the Conference a Communique has been prepared for release to relevant media houses, stakeholder institutions and government agencies. The Conference was chaired by the 1st Vice President Bishop Dr. Gordon Kissieh who until the election acted as the President of the Council.
