FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE SUSPENSION OF INDEFINITE STRIKE

The Divisional Executives Council of Public Services Workers union of TUC (GHANA), NIA Division, have resolved to suspend its indefinite strike declared on 10th of June 2024 pending the outcome of engagements with the Fair Wages and Salaries Commission on Friday, June 14, 2024.

The reason for this suspension is based on several interventions from stake holders including the Hon. Minister for National Security, the invitation from the Fair Wages and Salaries Commission to the negotiation table, the advice of the mother union based on the ruling of the National Labour Commission today, and the public outcry of decerning Ghanaians.

It must be noted that the FWSC have assured us of their willingness to act in good faith in our subsequent engagements. However, this gesture will be put to test on Friday, June 14, 2024. Members are therefore assured that, if at the close of negotiations on Friday, the government fails to demonstrate true faith by granting us Institution Specific Allowances, we would not be hesitant to return to our industrial action; this must be noted.

We hereby appeal to all members to report to work tomorrow Thursday, June 13, 2024, and professionally discharge our duties.

We appreciate your unprecedented massive solidarity and compliance following the declaration of the strike action. The action has really made tremendous impact. However, we anticipate favorable outcomes within the shortest possible time.

We also cease the opportunity to thank the media for their consistent and impactful report and the public for expressing huge interest in the matter.

While we comply with the interventions from the mother union (PSWU), the National Security Ministry, the National Labour Commission and the public outcry to stay put on hold the strike action, we throw a word of caution to Fair Wages and Salaries Commission and government to demonstrate good faith as we get back to the negotiation table in the interest of industrial harmony.
