**ATTORNEY GENERAL INAUGURATES 11-MEMBER CONSTITUTION
REVIEW IMPLEMENTATION COMMITTEE**

The Attorney General and Minister of Justice, Dr. Dominic Akuritinga Ayine, has inaugurated an 11-member Constitution Review Implementation Committee (CRIC) to advance proposals made for a review of the 1992 Constitution.

This follows the announcement of government's position paper on the recommendations made by the Professor H. Kwesi Prempeh Constitution Review Committee set up by His Excellency the President last year.

The Committee is Chaired by Presidential Legal Counsel and Former Attorney General and Minister of Justice, Ms. Marietta Brew Appiah-Oppong and made up of the following;
